



Hahndorf Primary School Dress Code

This code is in line with the Department for Education School Dress Code Procedure

Our expectation is that students come to school in Dress Code to maintain a respectful and safe learning community. The Dress Code is practical, suits a wide range of activities, weather conditions and is safe. Exemptions from wearing school dress code can be sought through a written request from a parent or care giver.

Dress Code:

- School dress
- School pinafore
- Black skirt/ skort
- Black shorts
- School winter skirt
- School winter trousers – plain black
- Plain black denim jeans
- Plain black tracksuit pants
- Polo neck shirt – school shirt or plain red
- Long sleeved round necked top or skivvies - red
- Sleeveless vest – black
- Jumper/ windcheater – preferably with school logo or PLAIN black or red (no other logos/ writing)
 - School beanie
- Plain black tights or leggings (to be worn under skirts/ dresses only)
- Sneakers, black school shoes



Not Acceptable at School:

- Thongs and slip on sandals
- Make up and nail polish
- Jewellery kept to a minimum
- Denim (other than plain black denim)
- Brand name and logo prints on clothing or socks
- Grey tracksuit pants
- Leggings by themselves
- Any pants with holes



When students come to school out of Dress Code:

- An explanatory note from the parent/ carer is expected
- If a pattern of non compliance is observed the class teacher will discuss the matter with the student and/ or parent carer
- Continue non compliance will be followed up by the leadership team

The following is encouraged:

- Outer jackets, parkas, raincoats – in school colours
- Scarves, gloves in school colours
- Hair accessories in neutral or school colours



Students are expected to wear red school hats when they are outside except for May, June, July and August
